Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Euro Alloys Ltd (“we”) use cookies and similar technologies for users of our website.

We use cookies to improve the website’s performance and user’s website experience – please refer below to details of actual cookies in use, how they are deployed, and their duration.

The legal basis for the use of cookies is your consent. We ask users to approve use of cookies when they access the website.

Your rights

It is important that you are aware of your rights in relation to us using cookies and processing your personal data obtained with them. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time by:

- refusing cookies altogether
- deleting cookies that have already been set
- modifying your cookie settings

Your web browser can choose whether or not to accept cookies. Most web browser software is initially set up to accept them and you should ensure that your web browser is set up to not accept cookies if you do not wish to receive them.

Please note that if users modify their cookie settings, some parts of this website may become inaccessible or not function properly.

What are cookies and how do they work?

“Cookies” are small text-only files of information that a website transfers to an individual’s hard drive or device used to browse a website (e.g. on a mobile phone) by websites that you visit. They are used to make websites work, to improve efficiency of websites, to improve the user’s experience, and to provide usage information on websites. This information should make website visits more productive by storing and using information on your website preferences and habits.
